THE CHALLENGE

The Georgia Health Information Network (GaHIN) faced the critical task of migrating from a legacy platform to InterSystems Healthshare without disrupting statewide services. At the same time, GaHIN needed to:

- Expand exchange reach through Carequality and the eHealth Exchange.
- Enhance registry reporting with more accurate, timely data.
- Improve reliability and scalability for millions of queries.
- Deliver smarter, analytics-backed alerts to providers and public health agencies.

THE SOLUTION

Ready Computing implemented Channels360 as the backbone of GaHIN’s statewide migration and expansion, now branded as Georgia Unify. The platform enabled a seamless migration to InterSystems HealthShare with no service disruptions.

Expanded connectivity, optimizing query flows while extending reach through Carequality and eHealth Exchange.
